School Assembly:

Parents are welcome to attend our weekly whole school assembly run on a Monday afternoon at 3.00pm. Throughout the year each class has an opportunity to run assembly and present or perform on a chosen topic.

New Families Barbeque (February):

Families of all new students are invited to a BBQ early in the year to meet and greet other families and get to know other students and staff.

Open Night (May):

Families are welcomed into the classrooms as an opportunity to see how the school operates, view the hard work students have been doing and to celebrate their learning.

Grandparents and Special Friends Afternoon (May):

A fun afternoon where grandparents and/or special friends join students in the classroom and partake in a fun and creative activity.

Book Week (August):

A major feature of Book Week is a fun dress up day where students and teachers dress up as their favourite book character. Students are involved in a whole school parade. The best dressed students are awarded with prizes.

All F-2 parents have the opportunity to volunteer in the classroom to assist students in Literacy and Numeracy rotations. Assistance with Foundation PMP is also vital for this program to run.

The annual school concert is a musical performance where every student participates on stage at Caulfield Grammar Performance Hall. Each concert has a theme and each year level tells part of a story through song and dance. This is the highlight of the year for the entire school community!!

Art Show (bi-annual):

A great community night that showcases our students' artistic talents, including an exciting auction with the opportunity to bid on some collaborative class pieces.

Performance Showcase (bi-annual):

A dazzling display of some of our most talented students, showcasing a variety of performing arts. This night celebrates students who have dedicated their time to in-school programs such as Wakakirri, Schoolaerobics and choir, as well as students who participate in external performance programs.

Foundation 100 Days:

A very special day for the foundation students to celebrate completing their first 100 days of school. Parents are invited to watch the 100 Days dress up parade, a highlight for most students.
